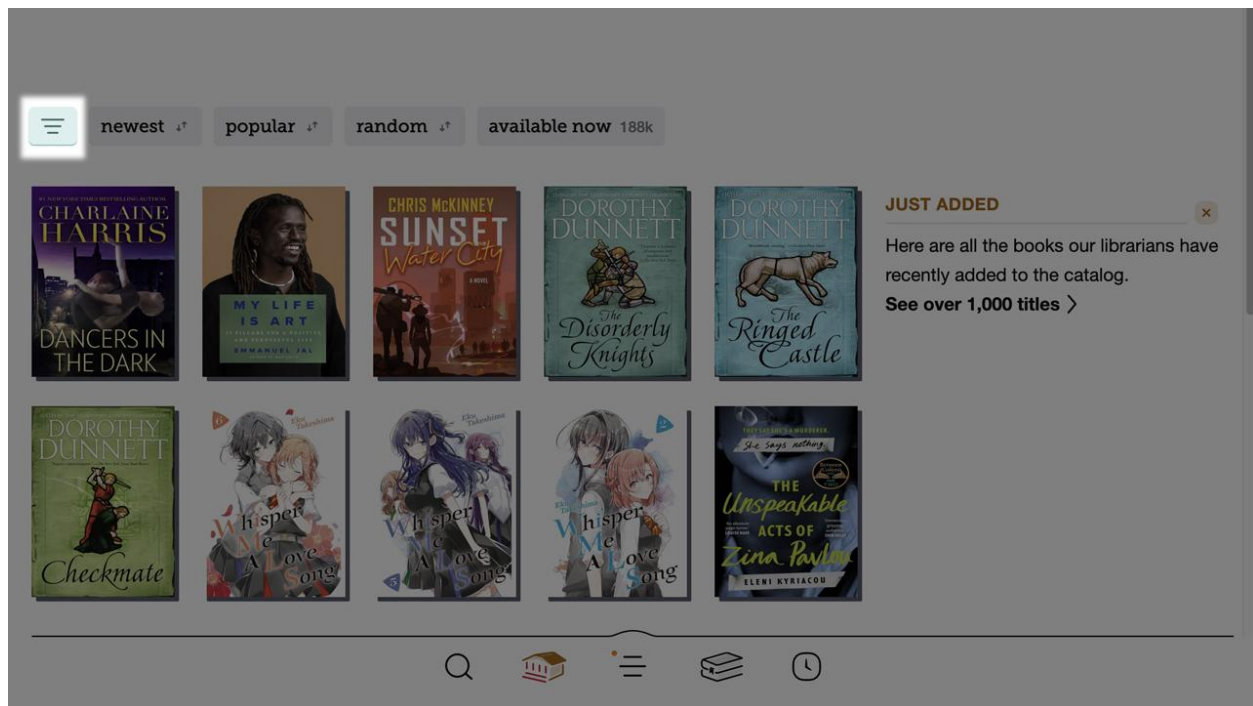
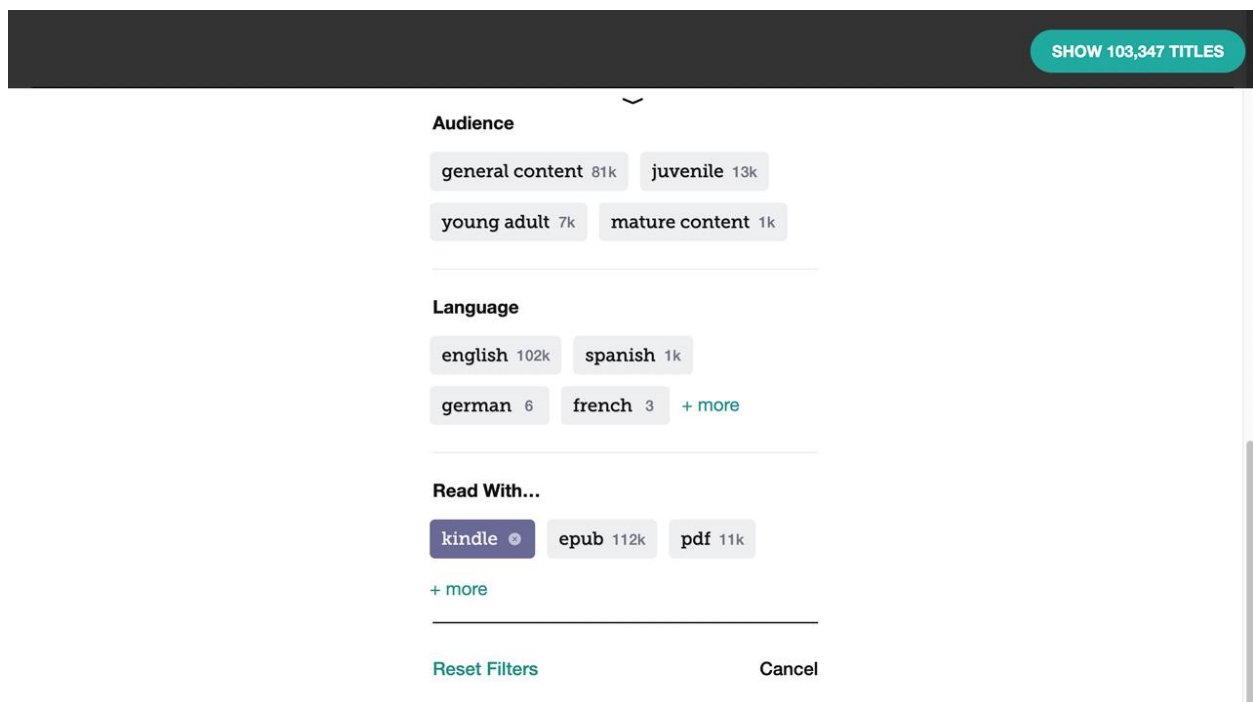


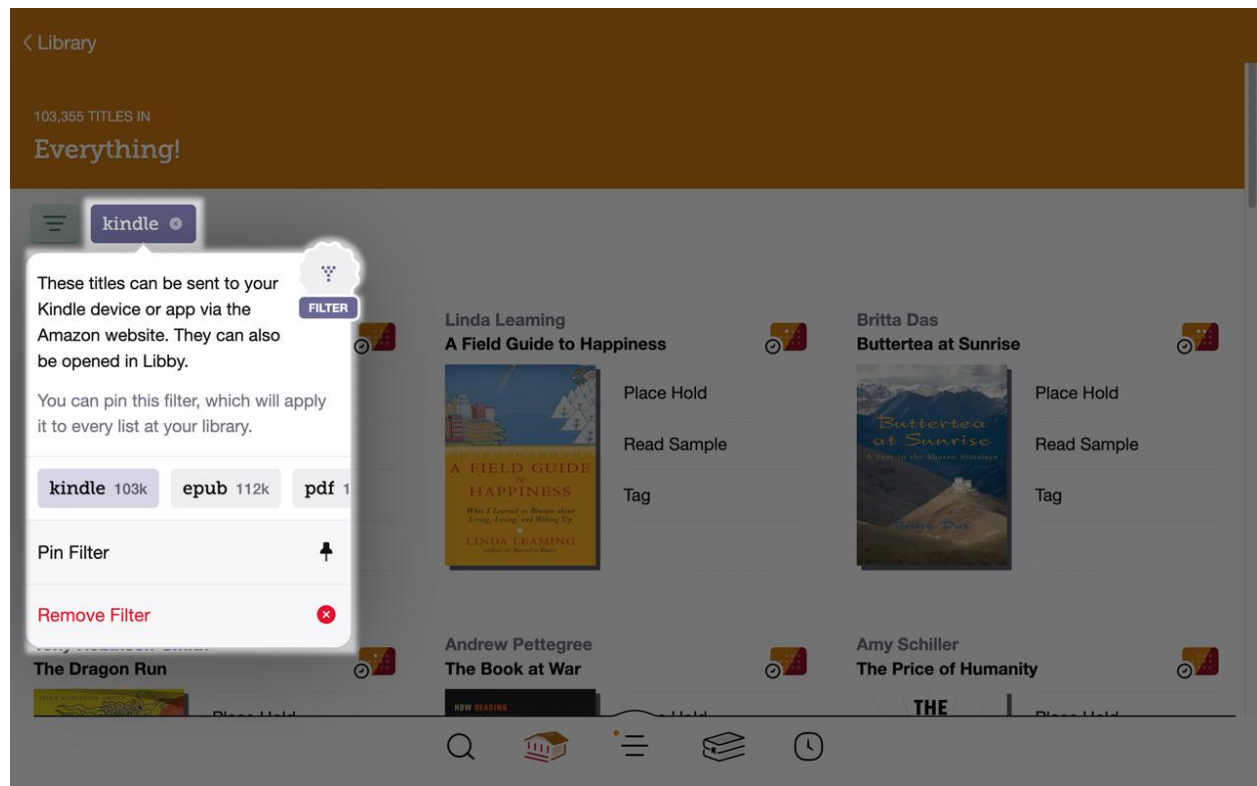
To find a book for your Kindle eReader, **click the filter icon**,...



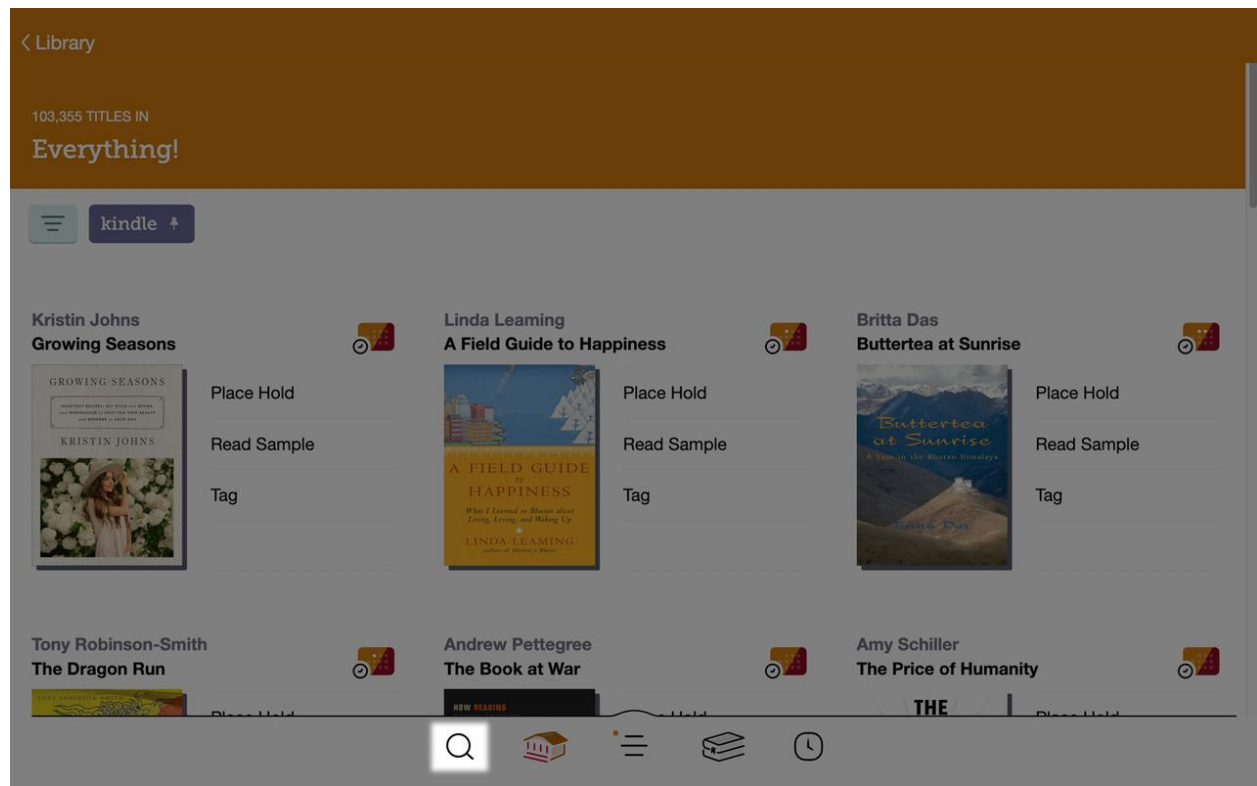
Scroll down to the Read With... section, click Kindle, and then click the Show Titles button.

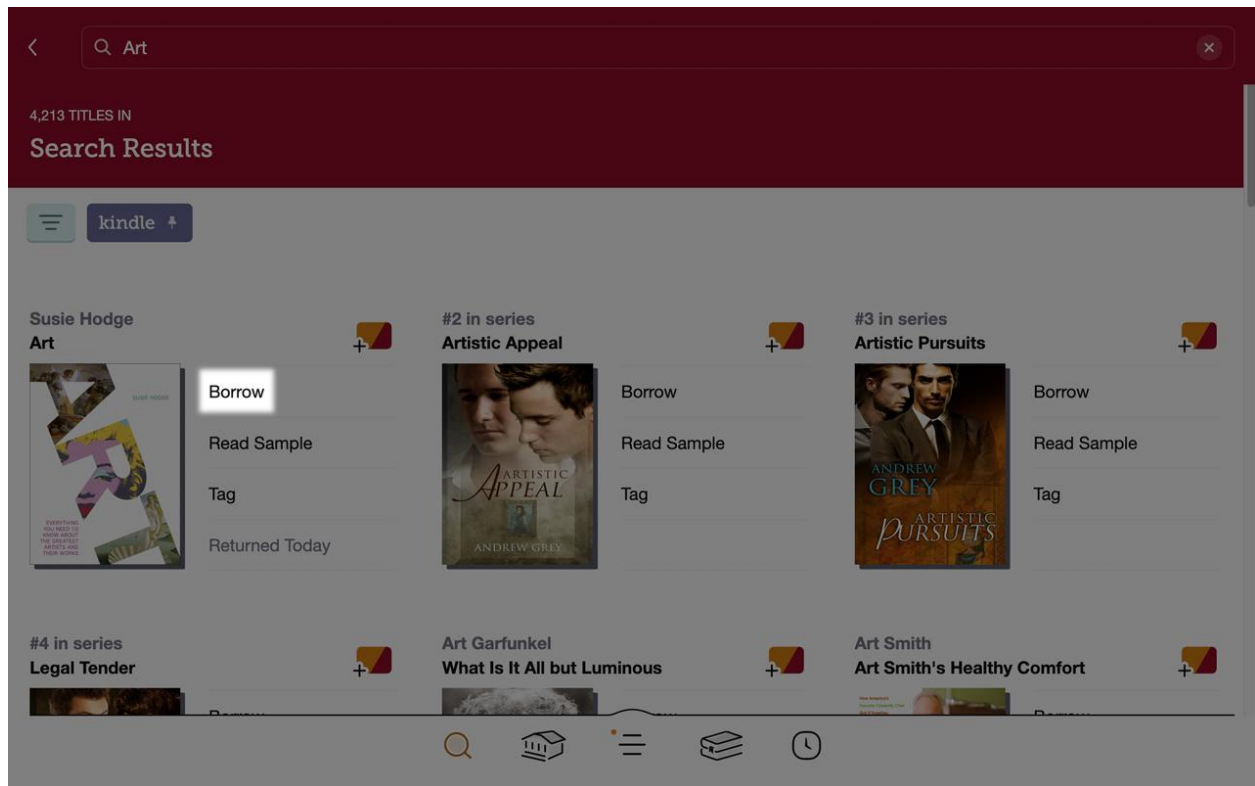

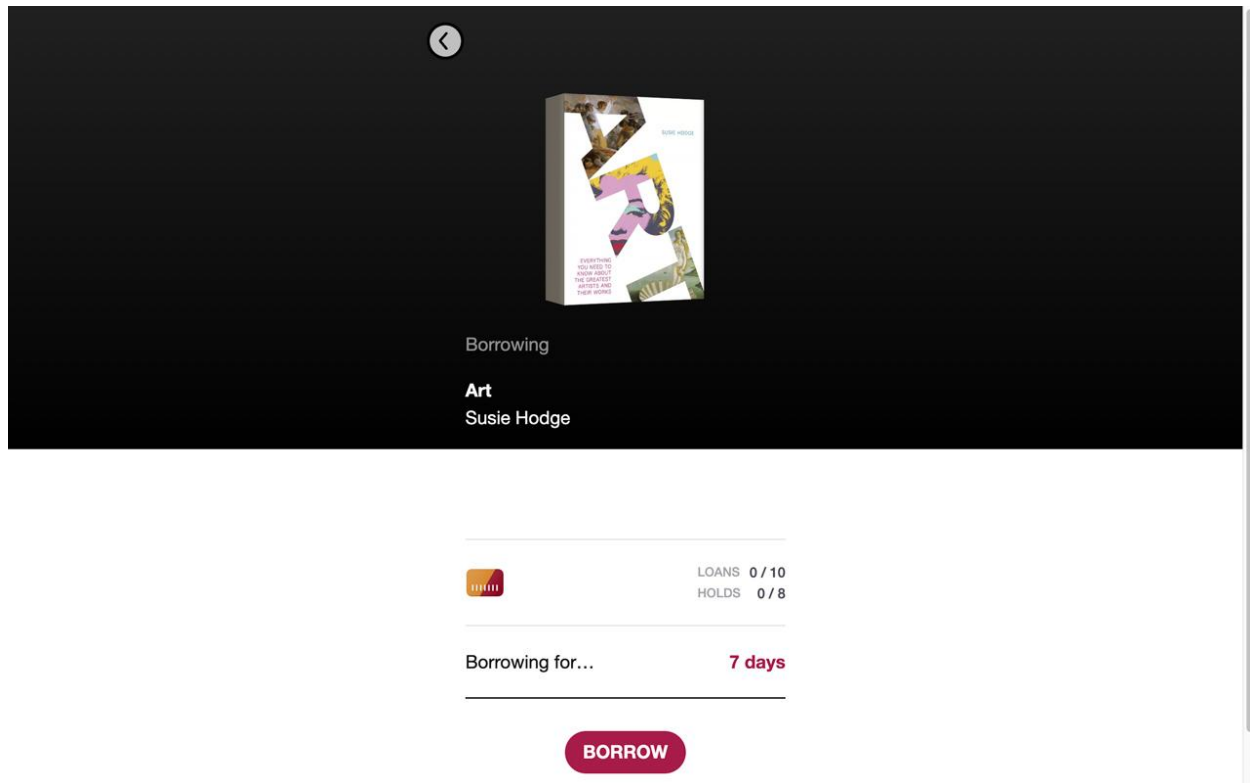

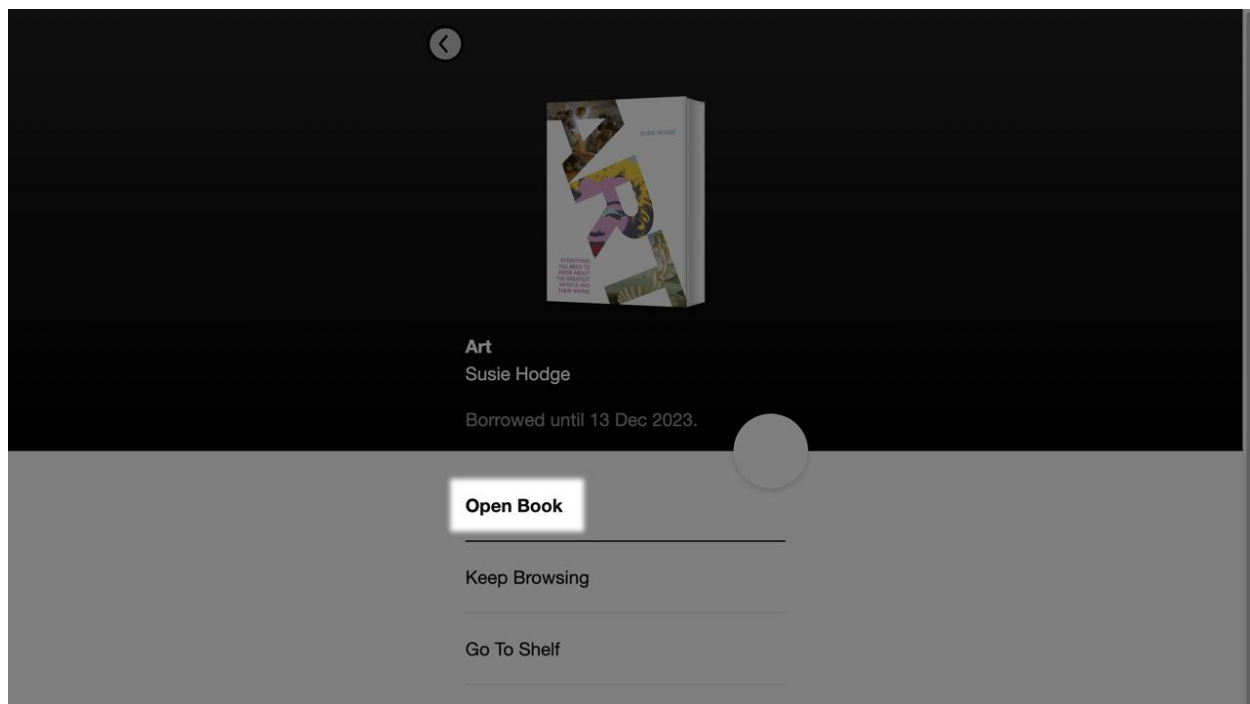
When you find something you'd like to read, **click Borrow**.



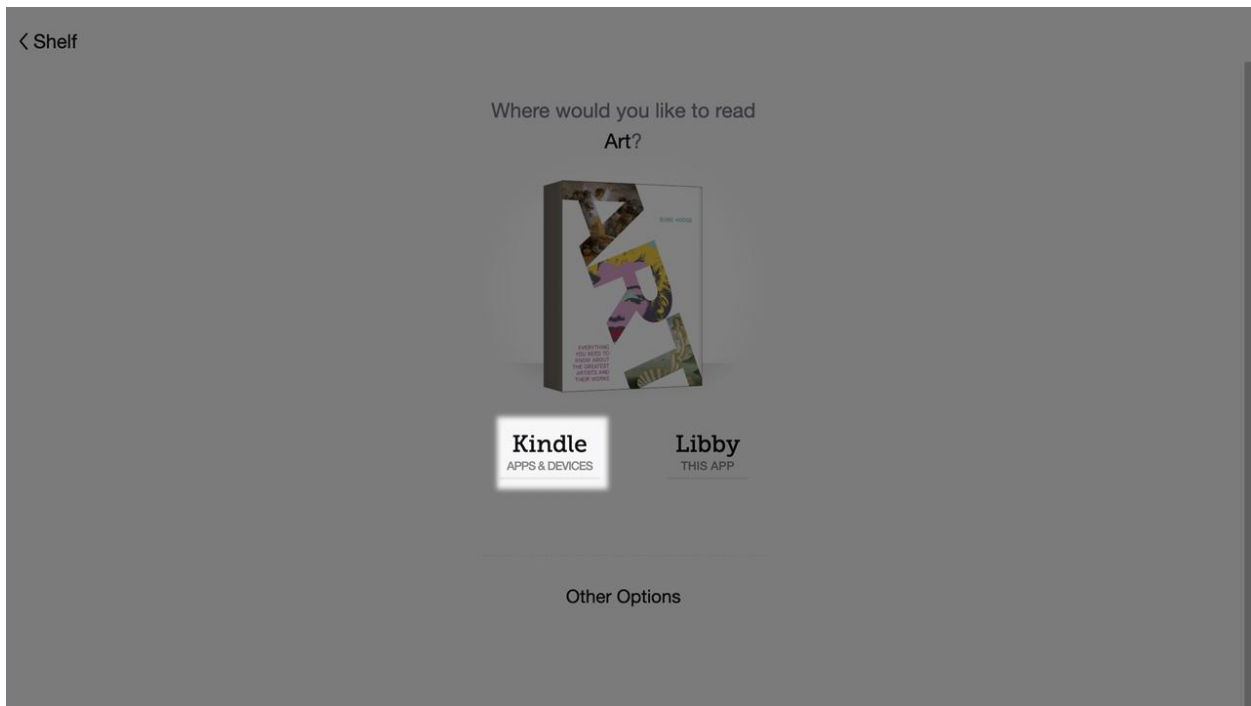
Click the “Borrowing for” dropdown menu and select the number of days you’d like to have the title. Then, click **Borrow**.



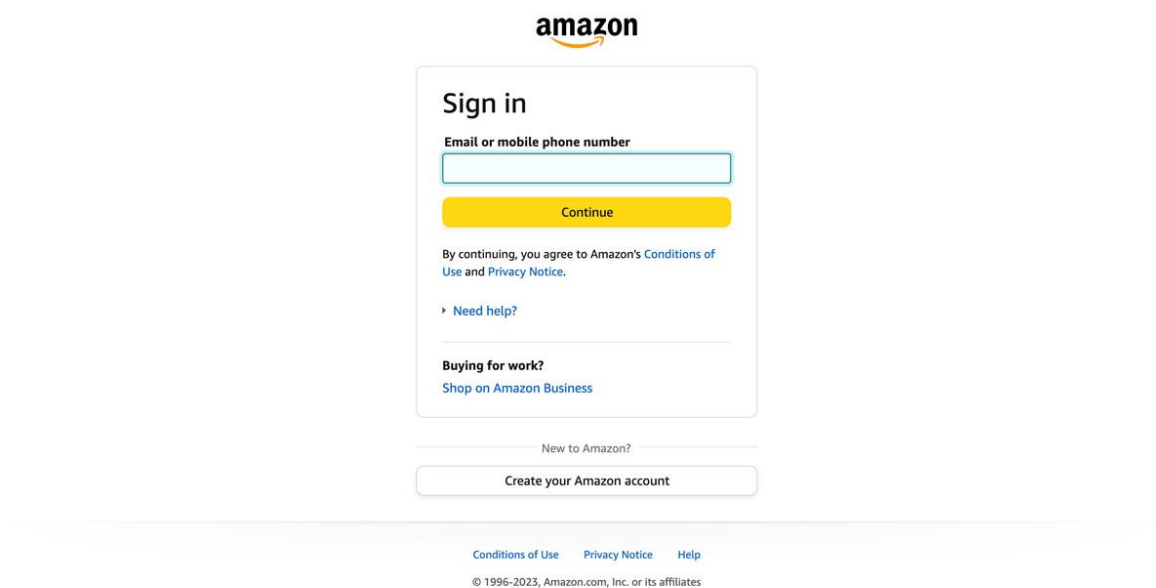
Now, click **Open book...**

Once signed into Amazon, **click Get Library Book.**

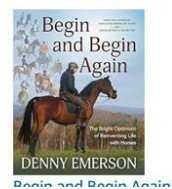
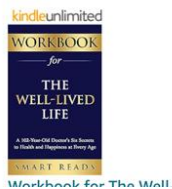
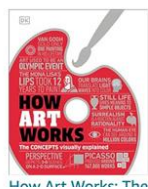
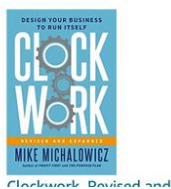
